
# Introducing: The Volkswagen 1600 TL Fastback.

The VW 1600 TL is for all those people who would like to drive a larger, more powerful car but who don't want to miss all the VW advantages.

#### With elegant lines.

Look at the smooth, flat lines of the front hood. And the projecting headlights. Look how wide the doors are and how large the windows. And take a good look at those solidly-built wrap-round bumpers. Notice the way the front flashing indicators, the sidelights and the large taillights all

help to emphasize the attractive, elegant lines of this car.

But the design's not only elegant - it's sensible, too.

Compact. Not as long and wide as possible but as long and wide as makes sense. That makes the



car more manœuvrable. In town traffic. On tight bends. Parking. Garaging. And in a thousand and one other ways.

However damaged a part of the body might get, fitting another part is quickly and simply done. For example, all four wings are bolted on – not

welded on. Even the door hinges are screwed on which makes fitting and removing them considerably easier. So you not only save time on repairs since less work is involved. You save money, too.

You see, this elegant VW body isn't just fash-ionable – it's modern, practical and sensible.



### With luxurious appointments.

The VW 1600 TL is a large, comfortable medium class car.

(With every inch of its spaciousness put to good use.)

All five occupants have plenty of room. And getting in and out is easy. (Even for weightwatchers – the doors are 42" wide.)

There's plenty of legroom, elbowroom and headroom.

The interior trim?

Luxurious, tasteful and comfortable. And with lots of extras at no extra charge:

Fresh air ventilation, heating, windscreen washer, parking lamps, headlamp flasher, assist straps, coat hooks, three ashtrays, five armrests, electric clock, hinged rear side windows, remote control of footwell heating outlets, mounting points for safety

belts, automatic locking device for front seat backrests, large glove compartment.

And this.

And the other.

Furthermore, the whole interior is fully lined.






All the instruments are grouped in front of you and

can be read at a single glance. They're all round, acknowledged to be the easiest shape for fast reading. They're all fitted with cowls to prevent windscreen reflection.

Two multi-purpose controls, which are shaped differently to make mistakes all but impossible even when it's dark, combine six functions. One is for the side lights, headlights and instrument panel lighting. The other is for the windscreen washer,



windscreen wipers and wiper speed. The stalk indicator lever combines the headlight dipper, headlamp flasher and parking lamp switches. The three levers to the right of the pull-out ashtray control the fresh air outlets at the windscreen and in the footwell. On the far right of the dashboard is the large, fully lined glove box. (With room for lots of things besides gloves.) Both the sun vizors are padded and swivel sideways as well as up and down. and the second s The state of the s

#### With comfortable seats.

We paid special attention to seating comfort in the VW 1600 TL. Because you drive the way you sit. That's why the individual front seats in this Volkswagen offer armchair comfort.

They're deeply upholstered and contoured to provide anatomically correct support. The seats are higher at the front to give you good upper-leg support and lower in the centre to give you firm

but gentle side support. Comfortable seats need good backrests – that's why we made them high and contoured them to give you shoulder-high, relaxing back supports.

Like to sit closer or further back than usual? Easy. Both seats are adjustable over a wide range – there are seven fore and aft positions and seven backrest angle positions. That gives you a choice of

Why has the 1600 TL got two luggage compartments?

Well for one thing there's room enough.


And for another because it has a lot of advantages for you.

If you have the luggage both at the front and at the rear you get better weight distribution and

the car handles better. And you don't need to have all the suitcases piled on top of each other with the one you want always at the bottom.

You can separate the luggage, too: Holiday luggage from overnight requisites. Passengers' luggage from your own.

The luggage compartments are clean and smooth,




typical of the high standard of workmanship on all VWs. There's no corners or sharp edges. They are fully lined with plastic material. That means your suitcases are well protected. In fact you could even put your clothes in without suitcases.

And the luggage compartments are easily cleaned with a damp sponge.


Spare wheel, jack, fuel tank filler neck and brake fluid and screenwash water containers are housed separately. Even after changing a wheel on a muddy road there's no chance of your luggage getting dirty.

Both luggage compartments are self-locking and can only be unlocked from inside the car.

And the underside of the car is a smoothsurfaced, one-piece platform, which prevents damage from flying stones, sand, water, mud and ice.

The 1600 cc engine is at the rear. Its weight's firmly over the drive wheels. No loss in power from a long, heavy prop shaft – it doesn't need one. The power's transmitted direct to the drive wheels.


It's air-cooled. That's why it keeps going even in tropical or arctic temperatures. On long, steep

mountain passes. And fast, modern motorways.

It's a low revving engine. That means less wear and tear and a longer life.

It's got twin carburettors. To make it even faster and give it extra zip. Yet, because it's a robust engine it thrives on regular fuel.

A fast car needs fast-acting brakes. Disc brakes on the front wheels and large, well-cooled drum brakes on the rear wheels mean you've got the sporty VW 1600 TL under control in any situation.




## There's a VW Variant 1600, too.

How about hobbies? Well, it's just the job for carrying precious model boats and aeroplanes.







Electrical System: Second interior light above rear door.

**Body:** Five-seater dual purpose car with folding rear seat and top-hinged liftgate, held open by torsion bar, rear window extending full width of rear door, and lockable press-button lock. Luggage compartments: in front same as in sedan, in the rear roof-high loading compartment, total volume of both compartments 31.2 cu. ft. Four quarter windows, two of them hinged.

Interior Trim: Leatherette on underneath side of rear seat cushion, rear side of backrest covered with rubber. Floor of loading surface completely covered with rubber. Side lining of leatherette. No rear parcel shelf and no central armrest in rear seat.

Dimensions, Weights, Performance: Height 57.7 ins. Rear door: maximum width height 42.7 × 25.4 ins.
